- **Contract:** The application fee shall be paid online through the payment gateway system provided in the online Application at the rate of Rs.50/-(Rupees fifty only) for SC/ST category and Rs.250/-(Rupees Two hundred and fifty only) for others.
- **Stipendiary Trainees:** The application fee shall be paid online through the payment gateway system provided in the online Application at the rate of Rs.00/-(Rupees zero) for SC/ST category and Rs.100/-(Rupees Hundred only) for others.
- Only SC/ST caste categories listed in the Kerala PSC will be considered. Applicants from other states belonging to SC/ST categories ,not listed in the Kerala PSC will be considered as General category.
- **9**. Candidates should produce the **originals Certificate** along with a **self attested copy** of the same at the time of interview.
- **10.** Communication of Interview/Test will be only through **e-mail/Website**. Candidates are advised to visit our website www.mcc.kerala.gov.in regularly for updates/notices and announcements.
- 11. Age will be calculated as on 1stJanuary of the year i.e., 01.01.2024.
- **12.** The experience will be calculated from the date on which requisite qualification is obtained to date of notification.
